Instruction

Guidance and Counseling Program

The School District will provide a student support program that will assist every student. The Director of Student Services will direct the School District's student support program.

Each staff member is responsible for effectively guiding students under his/her supervision in order to provide early identification of intellectual, emotional, social, the physical needs, and diagnosis of any learning disabilities, and the development of educational potential. The support staff shall offer counseling to those students who require additional assistance.

The student support program will assist students to recognize career options consistent with their abilities, interests and personal values. Students shall be encouraged to seek the help of counselors to develop specific curriculum goals which conform to the student's career objectives.
