

Parental Involvement

Community Relations

In order to assure collaborative relationships between students' families and the Board of Education and District personnel, and to enable parent(s)/guardian(s) to become active partners in education, the Superintendent or a designee shall:

1. Keep parent(s)/guardian(s) thoroughly informed about their child's school and education;
2. Encourage involvement in their child's school and education;
3. Establish effective two-way communication between all families and the Board of Education and District personnel;
4. Seek input from parent(s)/guardian(s) on significant school-related issues;
5. Inform parents/guardians on how they can assist their children's learning; and
6. Encourage parental participation in Title 1 schools in accordance with federal law.

The Superintendent or a designee shall periodically report to the Board on the implementation of this policy.
